For Large RV's, tent trailers, and overflow (if we have more than 50 pre-registered campers):

From March 21st, 2017 you may book your individual campsite at the adjacent **French Beach Campground** (\$26 per party per night, with one vehicle, up to 8 people). French Beach Provincial Park highlights:

- Situated along the west coast of southern Vancouver Island, easily accessible from Victoria (just over 1 hour drive)
- Fabulous views of the scenic Strait of Juan de Fuca and the Olympic Mountains
- Beautiful hiking trails through lush rainforests
- 1,600-metre sand and pebble beach, cold water swimming
- Home to pods of resident killer whales, otters, seals, sea lions, bald eagles, ospreys and other seabirds.

- Grassy, shady areas for tents (bring your own tent)
- Picnic shelter with sink with tap water, counters, wood stove fireplace, and electrical outlets
- Small camper vans can be accommodated (no electrical hookup)
- Campfire ring with benches
- 5 picnic tables
- Pit toilets (wheelchair access)
- 200 meters to seashore by forest trails
- 25 vehicle parking lot
